Parents:

Read - Psalms 127

¹ Unless the LORD builds the house,
those who build it labor in vain.

Unless the LORD watches over the city,
the watchman stays awake in vain.

² It is in vain that you rise up early
and go late to rest,
eating the bread of anxious toil;
for he gives to his beloved sleep.

³ Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD,
the fruit of the womb a reward.

⁴ Like arrows in the hand of a warrior
are the children of one's youth."

Pray:

- Praise God for blessing you with your family.
- Ask God to be the center of your family's life.
- Pray that your children would know and follow Jesus.
- Pray they would grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus.

Children:

Read - Psalms 25:4-7

⁴ Make me to know your ways, O LORD;
teach me your paths.

⁵ Lead me in your truth and teach me,
for you are the God of my salvation;
for you I wait all the day long.

⁶ Remember your mercy, O LORD, and your
steadfast love,
for they have been from of old.

⁷ Remember not the sins of my youth or my
transgressions;
according to your steadfast love remember me,
for the sake of your goodness, O LORD!"

Pray:

- Thank God for his steadfast love.
- Ask God for wisdom as you grow.
- Pray for your parents and siblings.
- Pray for boldness to share the Gospel with your classmates.

Parents:

Read - Psalms 78:4

"tell to the coming generation
the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might,
and the wonders that he has done.

Share:

Talk for a minute about a great thing God has done
in your life.

Pray:

- Thank God for his provision.
- Ask God to continue to bless your family.
- Pray for more opportunities to share how He has moved in your life.
- End by praying for your family members by name. That in Jesus' name God would use our families as lights in our community.

Read/Pray Together: Psalms 19:14
